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Science	5-11	The new topic, <i>Nature's Fury</i> will be studied, looking at the different types of natural disasters and their impact on various environments. Working Scientifically Skills for this topic will also be undertaken.																																
Geography	5-11	Students will be finalising their topic on urbanisation before continuing their practical fieldwork. Students will decide on the best space in QHHS to develop a vegetable garden, using a variety of research methods.																																
History	5-11	Year 9 history will be completing their focus study on Australians at war, specifically, exploring Australia's role in the First World War. Students will then move in the last 2 weeks to the time period between the wars- Boom and Bust; looking at the impact of war in peacetime.																																
PDHPE	5 - 11	The major focus will be on completing the practical components of the course with a focus on modified games and fitness activities. Students will also be required to consolidate learning from term 3 and complete lessons on the components of fitness.																																
Electives																																		
Food Technology	5 - 11	Students are working on practical outcomes for the course with a demonstration and practical lessons each week from Week 5 to Week 10.																																
Industrial Technology Engineering	5 - 11	Students in this course will be looking at practical aerodynamics with a project. Year 9 will be working on a rocket design and Year 10 will be designing and creating planes to test and evaluate																																
Industrial Technology Timber	5 - 11	Students are focusing on practical outcomes and finalising their in class timber projects in Year 9 & 10 for either the Tool Box or the Carry tray. Upon completion students will be honing on specific skills with smaller projects to finalise the year.																																
Industrial Technology Metal	5 - 11	The focus in Industrial Technology Metal is on creating, designing and finalising metal projects through practical work for the remainder of this term.																																
Child Studies	5 - 11	Students will be focusing on child, play and development with some lessons centered on practical activities for the remainder of the term.																																
Music	5 - 11	Students will be continuing on their study of Popular music through practical performance tasks and aural analysis. Students will seek to perform a song from a Popular music genre on an instrument of their choosing to demonstrate their technical proficiency developed over the year.																																
Visual Arts	5 - 11	Students in Year 9 Visual Arts will be focusing mainly on practical work for the remainder of the year. Week 5 will consist of consolidating what we learned about during online learning; Mythological Creatures and a case study of "The Garden of Earthly Delights" by Hieronymus Bosch. Then the students will then design a functional vessel incorporating aspects of mythological creatures. Once a design has been reached, the students will create these in a three-dimensional form using clay.																																

PASS	5 - 11	A major focus on the practical components of the course with students developing skills in Ultimate and modified sports. Students will address the key components of training for skill development and developing fitness specific to a variety of competitive sports.
Work Education	5 - 11	Work education will be completing a program where they develop and run their own business idea. They will develop practical skills focused on creating a business concept and organising themselves in groups to actively create the concept within the school environment.
Commerce	5-11	Year 9 will combine all their knowledge and skills learnt in the topics 'Economic Business' and 'Workplace Environment' to develop their understanding of how marketing plays a vital role in the success of a business. The topic will focus on how businesses promote their goods and services, understand the social, ethical and environmental considerations, analyse strategies used to maximise sales and understand other considerations when running a business These concepts will help them in their major class work where they will create their own business and promote their goods or service.
